

## AUSTRALIA ZOO WILDLIFE WARRIORS

### BACKYARD CAMPOUT 2019 - TERMS & CONDITIONS

#### **1. Requirements**

- a) Backyard Campout participants must register online at <http://www.everydayhero.com.au/event/backyardcampout2019>
- b) Backyard Campout is open to any Australian or international individual host participant.
- c) Each registration is for one individual only.
- d) Participants under the age of 16 must seek parental or guardian consent before registering to participate.
- e) There are strict laws pertaining to fundraising by children to ensure their health and wellbeing is looked after. It is up to that of the child's parent or guardian to research the laws and guidelines pertaining to their child's state or territory to ensure these are followed.
- f) Please note any child under the age of 8 years old is not allowed to partake in fundraising activities in some states in Australia.
- g) Any child 13 years old or under must be accompanied by a guardian at all times during participation.
- h) The parent/guardian is responsible for checking the fundraising guidelines of your individual state or territory to ensure participation complies with local government's legislation.
- i) Registrations for the program will be accepted between 29 May – 29 July, 2019.
- j) Fundraising commences once registration has been completed and an Everyday Hero supporter page is automatically created for you.
- k) Backyard Campout participants will have up until 11:59 pm AEDST on Wednesday 31 July 2019, to deposit all funds raised as part of the campaign to be included as part of their fundraising total.

#### **2. Activities and Events**

- a) AZWW does not purchase liability insurance to cover fundraising event activities conducted by third parties.
- b) In order to cover fundraising activities, there may be some circumstances where Public Liability Insurance is recommended.
- c) In these instances, Public Liability Insurance should name AZWW as an interested party in respect of fundraising activities conducted on AZWW behalf.
- d) A Certificate of Currency noting AZWW interest should be forwarded to AZWW prior to the event. Please discuss these types of events with the AZWW team who can advise accordingly.
- e) If the event is in a place which has liability insurance (such as a school, workplace, community centre etc), check with them to see what is covered. The event cover could be available under their insurance. That will assist to determine whether or not extra cover is required.
- f) AZWW advises not to ever collect money door-to-door or as part of a street collection, as it is illegal to do so without a licence.

- g) Please do not contact any organisations, sporting teams, associations or celebrities without prior approval from AZWW.

### **3. Authority to Fundraise**

- a) Backyard Campout participants who wish to raise funds and awareness through any activity or event in their local community must contact AZWW via email [info@wildlifewarriors.org.au](mailto:info@wildlifewarriors.org.au) to register their event and apply for approval.
- b) The Backyard Campout participant will receive a letter of authority which identifies them as an official AZWW fundraiser upon approval.
- c) If any approaches to businesses or corporations for sponsorship are to be made, approval must be obtained by AZWW beforehand.

### **4. Restricted Logo Usage**

- a) Backyard Campout participants will be provided with an AZWW community fundraiser logo to promote their event upon approval.
- b) This will be emailed upon approval of a fundraising event or activity.
- c) This may be used on any promotional material.
- d) All copies of any advertising and editorials mentioning AZWW and/or use of the logo must be sent to AZWW for final approval before being released.

### **5. Prizes**

- a) Fundraising for this campaign ceases as of 11:59pm AEDST 31 July, 2019.
- b) All funds raised in conjunction with this campaign will be calculated by the Wildlife Warriors team on Thursday August 1, 2019 and individual prizes will be mailed out accordingly.
- c) To be eligible for the top individual fundraising prizes, a minimum of \$800 must be raised during the campaign period. Individual totals will also be audited to ensure all eligible donations have been calculated to allow for system delays where applicable.
- d) Only one participant is eligible to win prizes or incentives.
- e) If the prize winner is ineligible, the participant may forfeit their prize.
- f) Top fundraising prize winners will be contacted Thursday August 1, 2019 to arrange postage details.
- g) Top fundraising prize winners are asked to please allow 21 business days from date of dispatch to receive your top fundraising prizes.
- h) Remaining fundraisers (i.e. those not eligible for top fundraising prizes) Please allow 14 business days from the date of dispatch to receive your prize pack.
- i) Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors reserves the right to alter or change prizes as part of Backyard Campout 2019, which may become subject to the prize availability.
- j) All entrants accept that the program organiser's decision is final and that no correspondence will be entered into regarding otherwise.

### **6. Privacy**

- a) AZWW has a privacy policy and the information provided during the registration process is necessary for conducting the Backyard Campout program and will only be used for this

- b) Comments made via social media maybe been seen as detrimental to the program and AZWW. These need to be monitored carefully, negative comments are not acceptable.
- c) Breach of these terms and conditions could result in expulsion from the program.
- d) Participants consent to the use of their name, image, photographs, video and comments in any publications and marketing, without payment of compensation.

### ***7. General information***

- a) AZWW in its sole discretion can at any time change, amend or vary these terms and conditions, and may change, amend, vary, exclude a participant from or cancel the Backyard Campout program without prior notice to the participant.
- b) AZWW has zero tolerance for bullying, discrimination and unnecessary targeting of other members of the program. Breach of this will result in immediate expulsion from the program.
